1 Assign 'Head/Lead' Students

Depending on the size of your school, appoint 1-2 head or lead students at each year level. Or even just 1-2 Senior Leaders and 1-2 Junior Leaders.

Consider building in some redundancy so volunteer leaders aren't burnt out from all their amazing mahi!

These students will lead the club and encourage other students to be active members

3 Integrate Your School Values

Also consider the 17 Sustainable Development Goals.

Involve all your members in the decision making process.

4 Plan Activities

The head/ lead students should make a plan at the beginning of the year/ term.

2 Make Teams

Create 'teams' to do different volunteer activities that align with the members' preferences and skills.

Consider the number of teams carefully.
